2012/2013 SEASON

Guidelines & Procedures

Any person wishing to be the Head Coach or Assistant Coach of any Central City Breakers FC team from U6-U18 must review and complete the entire *coaching selection process* form prior to the deadline.

All applicants will need to submit an *Application Form* (online only) before the designated deadline for the coaching season.

Coaches will be appointed by the Coaching Selection Committee who will comprise of members of the Executive and the Technical Development staff.

The appointed head coaches are responsible for appointing their team manager, assistant coach and female representative on or before September 1 of the current season.

Coach Selection Policy

- Coaching Application Deadline submission: January 18, 2012
- Interviews for Coaching Candidates (Metro/Gold/Silver/Select). January 19 -31, 2012
- Select (Metro/Gold/Select 1 & 2) coaches may be required to provide other documentation to assist in the application process (i.e. Training session plans, team goals, tentative calendar for the team)
- The length of term for each assignment will be 1 year. Coaches will need to re-apply on annual basis.
- Coaches are restricted to coaching a maximum of two teams and a maximum of one select team (unless otherwise approved by the Executive and/or Technical Director).
- Coaches will strictly adhere to the policies, procedures and philosophies outlined in the CCFBC Constitution and the Technical Department.

Dates to Remember

- Coaching Application Process commences: January 2, 2012
- Coaching Application Deadline: January 18, 2012
- Coaching Selection Process (Interviews if needed): January 19 -31, 2012
- Team Coaching Announced: February 6, 2012.
- Evaluation Camps & Team Selection (Boys & Girls): April 2 - May 17, 2012

Coaching Application Criteria

Coaches will be selected based on the following criteria:

- Level of Certification (see *Certification Standards*)
- Coaching Experience (*soccer-related*)
- Coaching Philosophy
- Relevant coaching and playing background (*both in or out of sport*)
- Commitment to coaching development and education
- Commitment to CCB's *Coaching Development Series*
- Support and commitment to overall Club Development Program and Player Development Philosophy
- Willingness to support CCB's Development Program
- Participation within the CCB's *Team Selection Process*
- Commitment to follow an age-appropriate Club Development Program
- Commitment to attend monthly coach's meetings (and/or have one team representative present)
- Willingness to sign the CCB's *Code of Conduct*
- Central City Breakers offers a wide variety of development and training programs. CCB endorses club-initiated programs and therefore any outside organizations is to be approved by the Central City Breakers' Executive and its Technical Director

Coaching Certification Standards

In our efforts to provide the highest level of coaching to our members, Central City Breakers FC encourages all coaches to further their coaching development. Central City Breakers will reimburse the course fee up to and including B Prep level; however, this is not to exceed one (1) course or \$200.00 per person per calendar year (September to August). Coaches wishing to advance to B Provincial or higher levels must have permission from the Technical Directors and CCB Executive before reimbursement will be provided. Travel accommodations and personal expenses will not be reimbursed. Receipt and proof of certification must be provided to the Treasurer.

Below is a list of Central City Breakers minimum coaching standards for each age group. These standards are in accordance with British Columbia Soccer Association's Coaching Certification Pathway. All head coaches are strongly encouraged to complete the following BCSA levels of certification within 12 months of accepting their coaching assignment:
